

**CALGARY AREA SCHOOLS SECOND ANNUAL

General:

- This tournament is for boys and girls of all ages and all skill levels. There will be competition at the Elementary, Junior High and Senior High levels.
- There will be a Team Competition, followed by Individual Competition.

Fees:

- \$15.00 per team (2 players team, mixed)
\$ 5.00 per individual event (max. 6 per school)
- There is a limit of 12 teams for each division. Each school can send one team per division. A school can send in extra team(s) if there are spot(s) available. Please submit extra team entries, and we will contact you immediately after the deadline.

Deadline:

- Friday, April 9, 2010 12 Noon

Supervision:

- Every school should have a teacher representative (or an approved Volunteer or Parent) supervising the participating students.

Clothing:

- Players should wear gym 'strip' and non-marking runners.

Food:

- Cultural Centre is right by downtown and Chinatown, so there are numerous places close-by to buy food and beverages. No food is allowed in the playing area. There will be spectator seats where food/beverage can be consumed. Any drinks or food garbage must be cleaned up.
- ONLY PLASTIC WATER BOTTLES with closed lids may be used in the playing area.

Team Competition:

- 3 divisions; Elementary, Junior High and Senior High. Maximum of 12 teams to be drawn into 4 groups. Round Robin plays within each group to determine order of finish. Firsts go into Tier 1 Knock Out playoffs to determine 1st to 4th position. Seconds go into Tier 2 KO playoffs to determine 5th to 8th. Thirds go into Tier 3 KO playoffs to determine 9th to 12th.
- We reserve the rights to seed teams if we know about the abilities of participants.

Individual Competition:

- 6 divisions; Elementary, Junior High and High School for Boys and Girls. We reserve the rights to seed players if we know about the abilities of participants.
- Each division participants will be drawn into groups of 3. Round Robin plays within groups to determine order of finish. Top 2 advances to the next stage of Single Knock Out format. Losers of Semi-Finals will play for third. Time permitting, a consolation Single Knock Out for those finishing third in their round robin groups.

Qualifying Entries:

- Any students who are willing to play may compete at their age level. If students would like to compete at the next higher level, they must be the top players in their school's group.
- A student can ONLY play in one individual event.

Playing Rules:

- ITTF rules apply. Game is 11 points. Match is best of 5 (Team match is best of 3 component matches, 2 singles and 1 double). Service of ball tossed at least 6 inches. Blades with proper covers.
- There will be umpires for all matches under normal circumstances.
