## Q & A

1. Why there are no rules for Team "B" on the entry form?  
All player enters the tournament the committee will "give" him/her a minimum 200 rating. For team B U-1200 average rating for each player is 400 (3x400=1200) and the max rating possible for a player is 800 (200+200+800=1200).
2. Why there are events marked in red on the entry form?  
The red events are the events we added after the entry form is completed.
3. What ratings will be used in the tournament?  
Feb 2010 rating will be used as Feb 2010 ratings are up on CTTA Site already.
4. What is team Olympic system?  
This is extracted from the ITTF handbook.

3.07.06.03	Best of 5 Matches (Olympic system, 4 singles and 1 doubles)
3.07.06.03.01	A team shall consist of 2, 3 or 4 players; each player shall compete in a maximum of 2 individual matches.
3.07.06.03.02	The order of play shall be A v X, B v Y, doubles C&A or B v Z&X or Y, B or A v Z, C v Y or X.

In this tournament we use the "modified Olympic system", 3 or 4 player team, order of play: A v X, B v Y, C/A(orB) v Z/X(orY), B(orA) v Y(orX), C v Z. We do not register the 4<sup>th</sup> player. The 4<sup>th</sup> player is only a backup.

5. How many events can I register?  
4 individual events, 2 team events, 1 doubles and a total of 6 events. Only 1 event per same start time is allowed.
