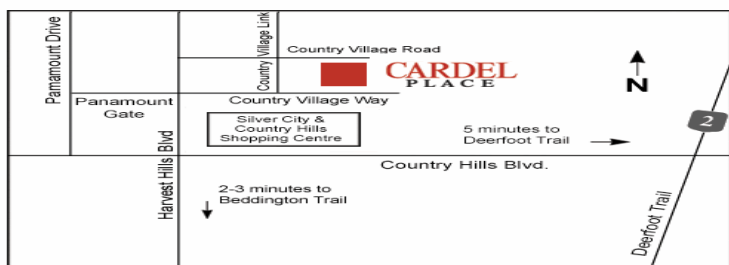

## 2008 Alberta Open — Information and Rules

**Entry Deadline:** 9:30 pm, April 6, 2008.

**Entry Fee:** Maximum 6 events (see the Entry form on the next page for details) are allowed to enter. Please pay cash at the Control desk during registration (You must pay the entry fee before your games start).

**Tournament Committee:** Carton Lao, Xiang Gui, Mengwei Zhao, Nesa Ilich, Bobby Chan, Lily Chan, Wendy Lau, Danny Ngai, and Phoebe Chan-Ngai.

**Eligibility:** Open to everyone but only ATTA members will be allowed in team selection.

**Classification and Rules:** The latest available CTTA ratings will be used. The latest ITTF laws (including the 11-point system and the service rules) will apply to all play.

**Non-Rated & New Players:** May enter any events but are subject to the tournament committee's discretion.

**Clothing:** The main color of the playing shirts, shorts or skirts should be different from the ball. Tracksuit bottom may be worn during play with the permission of the Tournament committee. Non-marking runner must be worn during play.

**Umpires:** Each player is required to umpire once for each tournament entry and once after losing a match.

**Default:** Five minutes late for an event after the player's name is called. In case of leaving the gym, please check with the Control desk for the time of the next match.

**Matches & Events:** Players should not enter events starting at the same time. All matches are best 3/5 except for the semi finals and the final of the Open singles events, which will be best 4/7. The first and second placed players in each preliminary round-robin group of the Open singles event will advance to the Championship stage, while the third and fourth placed players will compete in the Consolation singles; both use the single knock-out format. If possible, round-robin format will be used in all events at the starting stage except for the Open doubles and 2-player team events where the single knockout will be used from the beginning. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine or modify events based on the number of entries.

**Junior Events:** Must enter your own age group and may also enter the next higher one.

**2-Players Team:** The combined rating must be under 2200. The format of best 2 out of 3 matches will be used (A vs X, B vs Y, AB vs XY, where A & X are the higher rated players).

**Prizes:** Trophies, medals or plaques will be awarded for the winner and runner-up of each event. Cash prize will be awarded only for Open singles & Women's singles events.
