

TOURNAMENT RULES & INFORMATION

Entry Deadline:

9:30 pm, April 10, 2006.

Tournament Committee:

Carton Lao, Margaret Morett, Shuying Li, Wendy Lau, Conny Chio, Danny Ngai, Phoebe Chan-Ngai.

Eligibility:

Open to anyone but only ATTA members will be allowed in team selection.

Classification:

Latest available ratings from CTTA will be used. Latest ITTF laws apply to all play.

Non-Rated & New Player:

May enter any events but subject to Tournament Committee's discretion.

Junior Player:

Must enter your own age group and may enter the next higher one.

Rules:

The 11-point system and the new service rules will be applied.

Umpires:

Each player is required to umpire once after losing a match and once for tournament entry.

Default:

Five minutes late for an event after your name is called. If you want to leave the gym, please check with the Control Desk for the time of your next match.

Clothing:

Playing shirts and shorts or skirts should color other than the ball. Tracksuit bottom may be worn during play with the permission of referee. Non-marking runner must be worn during play.

2-Player Team:

The combined rating must be under 2200. The following format will be used: best 2 out of 3 matches. (A vs X, B vs Y, AB vs XY) A & X is the higher rated player.

Matches & Events:

All matches are best 3/5 except for the semi-finals and finals of the Open Singles events, which will be best 4/7. The first and second placed players in each preliminary round-robin group of the Open Singles event will advance to the second stage, while other players will compete in the Consolation Singles, both are using the single knock-out format. If possible, round-robin format will be used in all events before the single knock-out except Open Doubles and 2-player team will be single knockout. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to combine or modify events based on the number of entries.

Prizes:

Trophies, medals or plaques will be awarded for the winner and runner-up in all events. There will have a draw for a dinner for 6 at Eastern Fortune Restaurant sponsored by Eastern Fortune Restaurant for each person who enter the tournament his or her name will be in the draw list. We will have the draw before the Open Singles' round robin on Saturday. The person has to claim the prize right after the name is called; if not, then another name will be drawn again until the prize is given out.

Entry Fee:

Maximum 6 events (see the entry form on the next page for details) are allowed to enter. Please pay your cheque or cash to the Alberta Table Tennis Association (ATTA) at the Control desk **BEFORE** your games start.

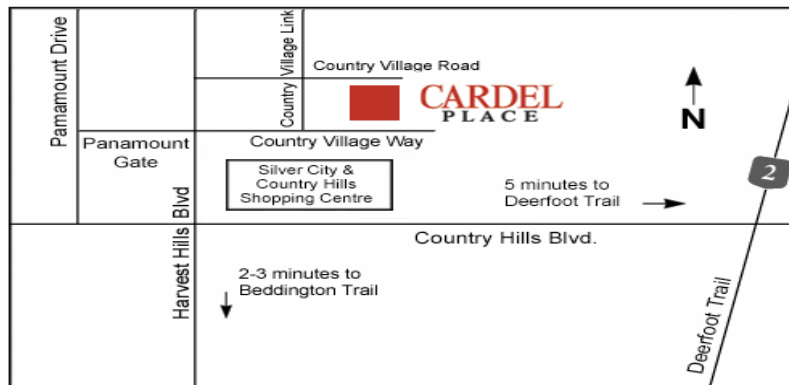
