





# 2006 CANADIAN JUNIOR OPEN

**ITTF WORLD JUNIOR CIRCUIT EVENT**  
**JUNE 8-11, 2006 • Edmonton, Alberta CANADA**

TABLE TENNIS CANADA is pleased to invite your Association to participate in the 2006 STAG Canadian Junior Open. The competition will be held from June 8-11. An ITTF High Performance training camp will be held in Edmonton from June 5-7.

<p><b>EVENT DESCRIPTION:</b></p> 	<p><b>JUNIOR BOYS / JUNIOR GIRLS (born in 1988 or thereafter)</b> TEAM EVENT, DOUBLES AND ITTF WJC SINGLES</p> <p>Singles – Stage 1 is a round-robin with a minimum of 3 players. Matches are best of 5. Stage 2 is a knock-out system with best of 7 matches.</p> <p>Teams – <b>NEW Olympic Competition Format – 3 players.</b> Match 1 - A vs X (Singles) Match 2 - B vs Y (Singles) Match 3 - C with A or B vs Z with X or Y (Doubles) – team choice Match 4 - A or B* vs Z (Singles) Match 5 - C vs X or Y* (Singles)</p> <p>* player not in Match 3</p> <p>Doubles – Knock-out system with best of 5 matches</p> <p><b>CADET BOYS / CADET GIRLS (born in 1991 or thereafter)</b> TEAM EVENT, DOUBLES AND SINGLES</p> <p>Singles – Stage 1 is a round-robin with a minimum of 3 players. Matches are best of 5. Stage 2 is a knock-out system with best of 5 matches.</p> <p><b>Team and Doubles same as listed above</b></p>
<p><b>VENUE / HOTEL:</b></p>	<p>The playing venue is the Kinsmen Sports Centre. The hotel is the Coast Edmonton Plaza, 10155 – 105<sup>th</sup> Street, Edmonton, AB T5J 1E2 (FAX: 780-425-5882 / TEL: 780-423-4811).</p>
<p><b>TRAINING CAMP:</b></p>	<p>From June 5-7, there will be an ITTF World Junior Elite Camp held at the same venue (and hotel) as the competition. The head coach will be named shortly, and will be supported by other high level coaches.</p>
<p><b>ENTRIES:</b></p>	<p>The entry fee is US\$100 (see Hospitality section for more details). A cadet player entered in the Cadet Singles event must progress to the quarter-finals of the Cadet Singles in order to compete in the Junior Singles. Players may enter only one age category in doubles and in the team event.</p>



<p><b>DRAW:</b></p>	<p>The draws for team events will be conducted on the 7th of June at the tournament hotel, at a time to be confirmed. The draw for the singles and doubles will be conducted on the 8th of June at the hotel, at a time to be confirmed.</p>								
<p><b>EQUIPMENT:</b></p>	<p>STAG 1000 DX tables (blue), STAG nets and surrounds (blue). White Butterfly balls will be used.</p>								
<p><b>OFFICIALS:</b></p>	<p>All matches will be officiated by qualified umpires. The referee will be an experienced International Referee. The Competition Manager is Mr. Raul Calin.</p>								
<p><b>TROPHIES &amp; AWARDS:</b></p>	<p>Trophy and/or medal for the winner, runner-up and semi-finalists in all singles and doubles events. In addition, prize money totaling US\$3000 will be distributed in the Junior Boys &amp; Girls Singles Events as follows:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1st \$700                      2nd \$400                      Semi-finalists \$200</b></p> <p>The prize money will be given in cash with no taxes or deductions taken from the winnings.</p>								
<p><b>HOSPITALITY:</b></p>	<p>The hospitality rates include the cost of the hotel room, all local transportation, breakfast and a tournament t-shirt. There is a cafeteria at the playing venue and there are many reasonably priced restaurants (US\$5 - \$15/meal) within walking distance of the hotel. Each non-smoking room has two double beds (please specify if a smoking room or one king size bed is desired). <p><b>TRANSPORT:</b> (UPON ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE)</p>	<p>The organizing committee will offer free transportation from the airport (Edmonton airport – YEG) to the hotel and daily transportation between the playing venue and the hotel. NOTE -- Transportation from the hotel back to the airport will only be provided for those who leave on June 11 or June 12.</p>								
<p><b>INFORMATION ON 2006 ITTF GLOBAL JUNIOR PROGRAMME:</b></p>	<p>The 2006 ITTF World Junior Circuit Programme consists of thirteen (13) Open Junior tournaments. Participants (Junior boys and Junior girls) accumulate performance points in a cumulative standing. The top 11 girls and boys in the overall standings, after all 13 events are completed, will be invited to the ITTF World Junior Circuit Final in Abu Dhabi, UAE (October 27 to November 3, 2006) with US\$25 000 prize money up for grabs. <p><b>ENTRY DEADLINE:</b></p> 	<p>The final deadline to submit your association's entry is <b>Friday, April 28, 2006</b> (preliminary entry by March 31, 2006).
