

TOURNAMENT RULES & INFORMATION

Eligibility: Open to anyone but only ATTA members will be allowed in team selection.

Classification: Latest available ratings from CTTA will be used and the ITTF Laws of Table Tennis will be in effect.

Non-Rated & New Player: May enter any event subject to the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

Novice Adult: Anyone over 18 years old and U 200 in CTTA rating. Previous finalists do not qualify.

Novice Junior: Anyone under 18 years old and U 200 in CTTA rating. Previous finalists do not qualify.

Junior Player: Must enter own age group and may enter the next higher one.

3-Player Team: Combined rating must be under 3600. The following format will be used: best 3 out of 5 matches. (A vs X, B vs Y, BC vs XZ, A vs Y, C vs Z)

U1500 Doubles: Combined rating must be under 1500. (can be 2 males, 2 females, or mix)

Consolation: After open singles preliminary round robin, the first and second placed players in each group will qualify for championships. The third and fourth placed players in each group will be eligible for the consolation event. However they must confirm right after the preliminary round robin.

Play: The 11-point system and the new service rules will be enforced.

Umpire: Each player is required to umpire once after losing a match and once for an entry.

Default: Five minutes late for an event after name is called. If leaving gym, please check with the control desk for the time of the next match.

Clothing: Playing shirt, shorts or skirt of color other than the ball. Tracksuit bottom may be worn during play with the permission of the Tournament Committee. Non-marking runners must be worn during play.

Prizes: Trophies, medals or plaques for the winner and runner up in all events.
