

ELIGIBILITY & INFORMATION

- AGE CATEGORIES: U-13, U-15, U-18; born on or after Jan 1, 1991, 1989, 1986 respectively; Seniors (40+), born before Jan 1, 1964; Senior (60+), born before Jan 1, 1944.
- TEAM EVENTS: Open Team: open to all players;
Team "A" : (U-900 each, U-2500 combined.)
Team "B" : (U-500 each, U-1200 combined.)
Senior Team : at least 1 over 40, 1 over 50 and 1 over 60.
Senior Team (60+): over 60.
- NOVICE EVENTS: Open to ALL players with rating U-250; previous finalists in Provincial Junior Events and winners of previous novice events NOT eligible in same event.
Adult Novice for players over 17 and with no rating.
- Junior players must enter their OWN age group and any ONE higher group. Maximum number of events: 4 individual and 3 teams/dbls, and should not enter events with SAME starting time.
- Latest available CTTA rating will be used at draw; Evaluation of un-rated players is at the discretion of the Tournament Committee; Latest ITTF rules will govern all play for sanctioned events. All matches are 3/5, and 11 points for each game except Open Single's Semi-finals and Finals, which are 4/7
- Team Play Format: 3-player team, A,B,C vs. X,Y,Z; (s.s.d.s.s);
A vs X; B vs Y; B/C (dl) vs X/Z (dl); A vs Y; C vs Z.
- EQUIPMENT: Stiga Elite/Expert Roller Tables; Stiga/Donic nets and 3-star orange balls.
- UMPIRES: Players required umpiring in round robin and the loser of elimination round umpiring the next round. The umpire is responsible to return the tournament ball and the match slip with the winner's signature on.
- DEFAULT: 5 minutes late after the event is called will be defaulted. (please report your conflict to the control desk if you are still playing other events)
- ENTRY FEES: Team Events: \$50 per team.
Individual Events: \$6 per player per event, plus rating fees for sanctioned events.
Junior Novice Singles:\$3 per event.
