

## RULES

### Eligibility

Players must be a member of a table tennis association recognised by the CTTA and/or ITTF.

### Classification

Most current CTTA ratings will be used. Inactive players will use their last known rating. The tournament committee reserves the right to make the final decision regarding the classification of any player.

### Matches

All matches best 3/5 except Singles semi-finals and finals best 4/7.

### Rules

Latest ITTF regulations, including 15cm service toss, red and black racquet, delay of game and 2 minute rest between games Non-marking runners. Track suit bottoms may be worn with permission of referee. No food or drink in the gym. Orange Butterfly balls will be used. If more than 5 minutes late after your name is called you will default the match. Be sure to check with the control desk if you have to leave the gym.

### Umpires

Each player is required to umpire at least twice. The umpire is responsible to see that the match slip is signed by the winner and that the match ball is returned.

### Singles Event

This event will be used to qualify for the 04-05 Canada Cup. The Men's and Women's Western Champions and runners-up will be invited to play the other regional champions at the Nationals in a special qualifying event. The top two positions from this qualification will compete in the 04-05 Canada Cup series. Present Canada Cup athletes will not qualify: i.e. if winner competes on Canada Cup circuit during 03-04, they will not compete in the National qualifier and the next in line shall take their place.

### Novice Event

To qualify as Novice you must be rated U250 and not have won a previous Novice event. If there are a significant number of Junior and Adult entries the organizers may split the event in to these two categories

### Prizes

Trophies or medals will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place.
