EVENT RESTRICTIONS: This is an "OPEN" tournament. All events except for the TEAM EVENTS are open to men, women, boys, girls, all ages, all levels - providing they meet the following entry requirements: "A" Singles - You must have a rating of >650 Cdn / 1465 US to enter. "B" Singles is restricted to players who have <1000 Cdn / 1680 US rating. "A" ("Open") Doubles is open to all players. "B" & "C" Doubles - the combined rating of both players must be <2000 & <900 Cdn respectively or their US rating equivalents. Youth, Mature & Senior Singles events are restricted to persons who meet the age requirements. The "No Kids Allowed Sgls Event" is restricted to persons who meet the age & ratings restriction. Players named to provincial or state teams in the Team Events cannot enter events #①,②,③ or ④. Players may not enter both the "A" Singles & "C" Doubles events; #⑦&⑧.

EVENT FORMAT: The "A", "B", and "YOUTH SINGLES" events are "TWO-THREE STAGE EVENTS"; i.e. based on ability - as defined by rating level - players are evenly distributed into preliminary groups of 3-5 players. Based on the results of these "P-Groups", players then advance to FINAL PLAY IN DIVISIONS 1-4, i.e. if you finish 2nd in your P-Group, you advance to play in the 2nd division etc. FINAL PLAY may be SINGLE KNOCKOUT or groups depending on # of entrants. MATURE, "NO KIDS" & SENIOR SINGLES events will be groups followed by single knockout. "A", "B" & "C" DOUBLES will be knockout draws with 1st round losers going into consolation draws.

RULES: International Table Tennis Federation Rules govern all play. Players must be members in good standing of the M.T.T.A. or their respective provincial/state Association. "A" Sgls 1st & Youth Sgls 1st Division matches are best 4/7 games to 11. All doubles are best 3/5. All other matches are best 3/5 games to 11 except finals & semi-finals of all events & divisions which are 4/7 games.

SANCTIONING: Tournament is sanctioned by the Canadian Table Tennis Association and results count towards Provincial & Canadian rankings and towards selection of Manitoba's Provincial Teams. "A", Youth and Mature (>35) Singles results count towards MANITOBA CIRCUIT STANDINGS.

 - The hotel is a short 3-4 minute walk from the gym.
 - Reservations can be made by calling the hotel direct at 866-826-4457 and asking for the "2007 Western Canada Open Table Tennis Championship Guestroom Block" of rooms. All reservations must be made by May 1st, 2007. After this date the guestrooms not booked will be released back to the hotel for resale. The price will still be honoured after this date, assuming there are rooms available.
 - Cost per room: \$89 per night for quad occupancy (Fire regulations allow for a maximum 4 people per room even with a cot). Choices of room are a) two double beds or b) King size bed with couch (opens to a bed).
 - Suites will be offered at \$129 per night for up to four people. (Regular price \$149 - \$169). These rooms allow for a fifth person at an extra cost.
 - The MTTA has a block of 15 regular non-smoking rooms and 5 smoking rooms until May 1st, 2007. The discounts still apply after the May 1st cutoff, but any rooms not reserved will be released for general sale.
 - Note: GST (6%) and PST (7%) are extra on all costs.
