Payment: Cash, Cheque made payable to "Edmonton Intergenerational Sports and Wells Association", or Interac e-Transfer to eiswa2025@gmail.com (please include player name and a complete list of events entered in the message when using Interac e-Transfer). Entry fee must be paid before the first match.

Cancellation/Refund: The tournament committee may modify, combine or cancel events based on the number of entries.

Refund of entry fee on event(s) cancelled by the player is allowed before 5pm on Wednesday, October 21st, 2026. After that time, there will be no refund on canceled or defaulted events (except for events cancelled by the Tournament Committee). Players are responsible for the full payment of entry fee on their registered events.

TOURNAMENT RULES & INFORMATION (cont.)

Draw: 6:30 pm, Wednesday, October 21st, 2026

Non-Rated and New Players: May enter any events, subject to Tournament Committee's discretion.

Eligibility: Open to everyone.

Classification: October 2026 or the latest available ratings from TTCAN will be used. Latest ITTF regulations apply to all matches.

Clothing: The main color of the playing shirt, shorts or skirt, must not be white. Tracksuit bottoms may be worn during play with the permission of the referee. Non-marking sole shoes must be worn inside the gymnasium.

Junior Singles: U-19 (born in 2007 or later); U-15 (born in 2011 or later); U-13 (born in 2013 or later). Players can enter the event of their own age group and one event of the next higher age group.

Under 600 Singles: Rating must be 600 or under.

Under 1200 Singles: Rating must be 1200 or under.

Under 1800 Singles: Rating must be 1800 or under.

Family Doubles: Double partners must be from the same family.

Team Events Format: three-player teams ABC/XYZ, Match #1: BC vs. YZ; Match #2: A vs. X; Match #3: C vs. Z; Match #4: A vs. Y (if necessary); Match #5: B vs. X (if necessary).

Team A: Combined rating must be 2000 or under; each player's rating must be 1000 or under.

Over 50 Singles: Born in 1976 or earlier.

Entry Events: Maximum four events per day; Maximum nine teams for Open Team; Maximum six teams for Team A; players **cannot enter events that start at the same time.**

Matches & Events: All matches are best of five. Exception: Round-robin in Team events are best of three; semi-finals and final in the Open Singles event are best of seven.

Prizes: Trophies, medals, or plaques will be awarded to the winner and runner-up in all events. There will be cash prizes for the winner(s) and runner-up(s) of Open Singles and Open Doubles events (Amount of cash prize to be determined by the tournament committee and will be announced at the tournament), and mystery gift for the winner(s) and runner-up(s) of Under 1800 and Family Doubles.

Umpires: For Semi-finals and Finals, umpires will be assigned. Only players participating in a match may request an umpire for that match if needed.

Default: A player who is five (5) minutes late after their name is called for an event will be defaulted. If you leave the gym, check with the Control Desk for the time of your next or remaining match(es).

ATTA Membership Fee:

Current ATTA membership (individual or affiliated club member) is required for all participants in Alberta; otherwise, a \$20 (\$15 for juniors) ATTA individual membership fee will be charged. Proof of membership must be provided when registering.
